

Permits during Fire Season 2015 - 2016

In January 2016, the decision was made to suspend the issuing of permits unless there was a specific need. Weather conditions have changed significantly since then with good rain falling across the entire Monaro District.

After consultation with Group Captains, and as at 2400hrs on Friday 5 February 2016, the issuing of permits will revert to our **normal Fire Danger Period policy**. It is strongly recommended however, that careful thought be given to issuing permits as several weeks remain before the ending of the Fire Danger Period and weather conditions may well become hot and dry. With this in mind, all permit officers are requested to consider keeping the duration of the permit as short as possible, preferably 48hrs (refer: [Considerations When Burning During a Restricted Permit Period](#)).

If a permit is required, it is suggested that the Brigade be contacted to discuss the matter.
